Australian Longline own and operate two Australian flagged longline vessels which operate in the Heard and McDonald Island, Macquarie Island and Antarctic waters to fish for Patagonian and Antarctic Toothfish.

Your new role

Based in Hobart, Tasmania, you will be responsible for the overall co-ordination of repairs and maintenance, survey, dry docking and ongoing maintenance management, which will include:

- Development of maintenance plans and budgets
- Liaise with authorities and government departments to ensure vessel compliance and statutory requirements

- Work with Ships Engineers and Management to implement timely and effective planning and co-ordination of vessel maintenance and repairs
- Collaborate on cost reduction initiatives and opportunities for innovation to improve business outcomes
- Oversee procurement of engineering parts required to undertake repairs and maintenance
- Compile reports, implement processes, procedures, work instructions and scopes of work to support the vessel operations, repairs and maintenance
- Ensure compliance with work, health and safety legislation
- Active involvement with safety management systems.
